INITIAL VISIT STATEMENT AND RELEASE FORM

It is our intention to keep you as well informed about tanning as possible. This means informing you on how to operate the equipment, and the possible negative effects of tanning as well as the obvious positive effects. The proper procedure to follow in the tanning room will be clearly explained by the attendant. Please feel free to ask any questions or to voice any concerns that you might have at this time. We thank you for your cooperation and hope we can work together to provide you with the healthiest tan possible.

DANGER – ULTRAVIOLET RADIATION

- Follow operator, tanning unit, eyewear, and safety instruction.
- Avoid too frequent or lengthy exposure. As with natural sunlight, exposure to a sunlamp may cause eye and skin injury, sunburn, and allergic reactions. Repeated overexposure may cause chronic damage characterized by wrinkling, dryness, premature aging of the skin, and skin cancer.
- Wear Protective eyewear.

FAILURE TO USE PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR MAY RESULT IN SEVERE BURNS OR LONG TERM INJURY TO THE EYES.

- Abnormal or increased skin sensitivity or burning may be caused by certain foods, medications (including but not limited to tranquilizers, diuretics, antibiotics, high blood pressure medication, birth control pills and skin creams), cosmetics and toiletries. Consult a physician or pharmacist before using a sunlamp if you are using prescription or non-prescription medications, have a history of skin problems, or believe yourself to be especially sensitive to sunlight. Pregnant women and women on birth control pills who use a tanning device may develop discolored skin.
- Ultraviolet radiation from sunlamps enhances the effects of the sun. Do not sunbathe before or after exposure to ultraviolet radiation.
- If you do not tan in the sun, you are unlikely to tan from the use of this product.
- Use of a tanning device may not provide a protective base in regards to sun exposure.

I verify with my signature, that I am 18 years of age or older as required by law (Parental consent for minors required below). I understand and have been made aware, that under **Illinois law, I am only permitted to tan in a 24-hour** period. I have been given instructions for the proper use of the equipment and I will use it at my own risk. I hereby release the owners, operators, and manufacturers from any damages that I might incur due to the use of these facilities.
